The #2 reason why students choose to study at Caldwell College is our focus on the development of global citizens. This outcome is connected to the Catholic Dominican tradition of social justice and a commitment to build a more just and compassionate global community. These models guide the Dominican Republic Education Abroad Mentoring Sophomore (DREAMS) Leaders Program.

Caldwell selected the Dominican Republic (DR) as a non-traditional study abroad location that can provide a personal transformative learning experience as you study the social and economic impact of a variety of policies on the DR's displaced people among whom you will perform service.



What is the DREAMS Program?

The DREAMS Leaders program is an innovative 1-year comprehensive unique college experience combining six academic credits and a short-term study abroad with authentic service learning experiences—both in the DR and US. Students apply during their 2nd semester freshman year and participate in DREAMS during their sophomore year. All activities will help build your leadership skills and support your progress into your junior year.

How Do I Apply . . .

All 2nd semester freshmen with a 2.5+ GPA in good academic and social standing are eligible to apply. Space is limited!

- A timely application indicating reason for participation and stated personal leadership goal to be achieved upon program completion
- Faculty recommendation attesting to qualifications and maturity
- Personal and group interviews with the DREAMS Leaders Selection Committee
- \$300 non-refundable deposit
- Meeting with the Office of Financial Aid to discuss financial options.
